Item A: Approve/Disapprove transfer of funds for brush/bulk pick up

Mayor Gillespie explained the cost estimate for the pick up is higher than anticipated; it will cost approximately \$20,000. Discussion occurred concerning the amount of brush/bulk items being hauled off, the fact that it is done before hurricane season is a good thing, the city's appearance is much improved by the pick up and that future pick ups will need to be discussed at a later meeting.

Alderman Ehmann suggested the funds be moved from capital improvements since the road repairs came in under what was allocated. Alderman Marroquin made the motion to increase the budget for brush pick up an additional \$14,500 out of Capital Improvement. Alderman Ehmann seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
