- I. City Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Ehmann at 7:28 p.m.
- II. Alderman Nyberg gave the Invocation.
- III. Mayor Ehmann led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Item A: Planning & Zoning: Planning And Zoning will have their next meeting September 13th, 2022.
