- I. City Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Ehmann at 7:00 p.m.
- II. Alderman Nyberg gave the Invocation

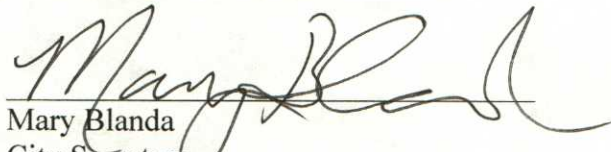

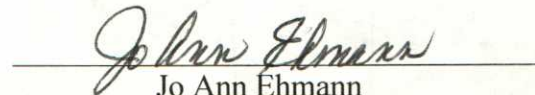
