

CITY OF INGLESIDE ON THE BAY  
CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
June 18, 2024

- I. City Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Ehmann at 7:00 p.m.
- II. Roll Call: Mayor Ehmann, Alderman Nyberg, Daley, Wilder, Jolly and Merrick were all present.
- III. Alderman Nyberg gave the Invocation.
- IV. Mayor Ehmann led the Pledge of Allegiance, both US and Texas.
- V. Minutes of Previous City Council Meeting of May 7, 2024 were approved as written. Alderman Nyberg made the motion to approve, Alderman Wilder seconded and the motion carried. Alderman Merrick abstained because he was not present for the May 7<sup>th</sup> meeting.
- VI. Alderman Merrick gave a treasurer report for March, April and May of 2024.
- VII. Citizen Participation: Cyndi Valdes spoke about providing a live stream feed of the city council meetings. She believes that many people are unable to attend and a live feed would be beneficial.
- VIII. Reports from Standing Committees: Non-Action Items
  - Item A: Planning and Zoning: No Report
  - Item B: Parks and Recreation: Non-Action Items
    1. The 4<sup>th</sup> of July Golf Cart Parade will be on Thursday July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Lineup is at 5:45pm at City Hall and it will start at 6pm. The parade will end at Sunset Hideaway/Marina. Military Flags will be placed on the park on July 4<sup>th</sup>. Bring your family to enjoy Fireworks sponsored by Kiewit.

An event will be held on Saturday, August 10, 2024, from 3-5pm at IOB City Hall where kids can enjoy ice-cream with toppings and pick out school supplies.

    2. An engine temperature gage on the pump panel was replaced.

3. The Chief attended the Texas Emergency Management Conference May 28-31 in Fort Worth.
4. There will be a funeral Sunday June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2024 for local firefighter Abel Aguirre age 33.
5. The Chief briefed the citizens of IOB on potential Tropical Storm Alberto. Plan for potential 3ft of flooding, winds between 35-45mph and 4-10" of rain.

IX. Old Business: Discussion and Possible Action

Item A: Alderman Tom Merrick was sworn in and seated by City Secretary, Mary Blanda.

Item B: A motion to approve the reappointment of Planning and Zoning Applicants Marietta Grimes, Idana Merrick and Sheila Walton was made. The motion was made by Alderman Wilder, seconded by Alderman Daley and it carried unanimously.

X. New Business: Discussion and Possible Action

Item A: Buddy Wooldridge of Moonshot Recycling gave a presentation about his recycling services. He had hoped for a city contract but the council was unwilling to obligate the citizens to additional fees on their monthly utility bills. However, his services are available on an individual basis. His business card can be found at city hall for citizens interested in recycling.

Item B: Ordinance No. 2024-04; Amending Zoning Ordinance 2010-02 and Repealing and Replacing Ordinance 2011-03 was passed. Alderman Daley made the motion, Alderman Nyberg seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Item C: Resolution No. 24-356, a contract with AEP, was passed. Alderman Daley made the motion, Alderman Wilder seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Item D: A Community Development Block Grant-Mitigation Interlocal Agreement between San Patricio County, Texas and the City of Ingleside on the Bay, Texas was approved. Alderman Nyberg made the motion, Alderman Jolly seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Item E: Parks and Recs requested monies for four items. \$600.00 for IOB 2025 Calendars, \$125.00 for a Veterans Day event and \$500.00 for Christmas Decorations requests were tabled for next year's budget. \$200.00 was approved for School Supplies and Ice Cream. The motion to approve was made by Alderman Daley, seconded by Alderman Nyberg and it carried unanimously.

XI. Mayor Ehmann made a closing announcement concerning 2024-2025 budget requests. She asks that all requests be submitted by the end of June, 2024.

XII. Adjournment: Meeting was adjourned at 8:00pm.
