

AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING AND DECLARING
THE RESULTS OF THE ELECTION HELD ON THE
15th DAY OF JANUARY, 1994 FOR THE
ADOPTION OF A MUNICIPAL SALES AND USE TAX

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Ingleside on the Bay:

SECTION 1. On the 15th day of January, 1994, a duly called election for the election of municipal officers and to consider the adoption of a municipal sales and use tax was held by Ingleside on the Bay. The election was held in accordance with the Texas Election Code and all qualified voters were allowed to vote in such election. Included in the ballot was a provision for voting for or against the following proposition:

"A one (1) percent sales and use tax is adopted within the City."

SECTION 2. The total number of votes cast on the sales tax proposition was 142. The total number of votes cast in favor of the proposition was 131. The total number of votes cast against the proposition was 11. The number of votes by which the proposition was approved was 131.

SECTION 3. The City Council of the City of Ingleside on the Bay hereby finds and declares that the election for the adoption of a municipal sales and use tax was properly and validly held under the Texas Election Code. It is further found and determined that the proposition for the imposition of a one (1) percent sales and use tax passed and such tax should hereby be imposed within the City limits of the City of Ingleside on the Bay.

SECTION 4. There is hereby levied and adopted the municipal sales and use tax as provided in Subtitle C., Chapter 321, Texas Tax Code, within the City of Ingleside on the Bay in accordance with provisions of the cited statute.

SECTION 5. The municipal secretary is hereby authorized and instructed to send to the Comptroller by United States Certified or Registered Mail a certified copy of this ordinance along with a map of the municipality clearly showing its boundaries.
