## ORDINANCE NO. 99-08 AN ORDINANCE DECLARING EACH UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE IN THE JANUARY 15, 2000 ELECTION ELECTED TO OFFICE WITHOUT REQUIREMENT OF VOTE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLESIDE ON THE BAY, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City Council has received a certification of unopposed status from the City Secretary certifying that Alfred D. Robbins as Mayor, and Betty Harbaugh and Jimmy Morgan as Council Members on the City Council are unopposed for the respective vacancies, only one candidate's name is to be placed on the ballot for each office, and no candidate's name is to be placed on a list of write-in candidates.
