

**ORDINANCE NO. 99-08**  
**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING EACH UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE**  
**IN THE JANUARY 15, 2000 ELECTION ELECTED TO OFFICE**  
**WITHOUT REQUIREMENT OF VOTE**

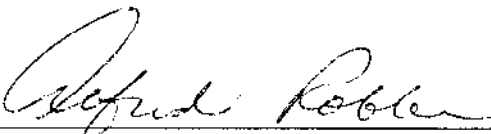
**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLESIDE ON THE BAY, TEXAS:**

**Section 1.** The City Council has received a certification of unopposed status from the City Secretary certifying that Alfred D. Robbins as Mayor, and Betty Harbaugh and Jimmy Morgan as Council Members on the City Council are unopposed for the respective vacancies, only one candidate's name is to be placed on the ballot for each office, and no candidate's name is to be placed on a list of write-in candidates. The certification is attached hereto as Exhibit 1. The City Council pursuant to Texas Election Code, Chapter II, Subchapter C, Section 2.051, et seq, orders and declares Alfred D. Robbins as unopposed candidate for Mayor and he is elected to the office of Mayor. The City Council pursuant to Texas Election Code, Chapter II, Subchapter C. Section 2.051, et seq, orders and declares Betty Harbaugh and Jimmy Morgan as unopposed candidates are elected to the office of City Council.

**Section 2.** A certificate of election shall be issued to each such candidate in the same manner as provided for a candidate elected at the election.

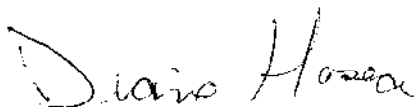
Dear Mayor and City Council:

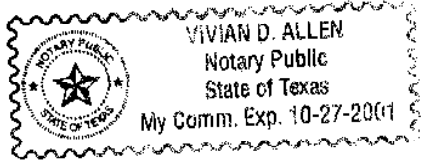
