

AN ORDINANCE 2003-05

ESTABLISHING A RATE FOR SANITARY SEWER SERVICE;  
PROVIDING FOR TAP FEES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT;  
PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLESIDIE ON THE BAY:

Section 1. Charge for Sanitary Sewer service. The charge for sanitary sewer service shall be based on the amount of water usage as measured by each individual water meter. In addition to the charge for water, a charge shall be made to each account as follows:

\$25.00 for the first 2,000 gallons of water

\$ 2.00 for each additional 1,000 gallons.

Each account will be billed monthly for sanitary sewer service in accordance with the rules, regulations and schedule for billing for water service. Failure to pay the monthly fee shall result in termination of water service to the account billed. Service shall not be reinstated at any location so terminated until and unless the full bill, water and sewer, is paid and brought current, including any required disconnect and reconnect fees.

Section 2. Tap fees. There is no tap fee for any tap installed <sup>before May 31, 2002</sup> under the initial hook up program by the City of Ingleside on the Bay. Thereafter, there is a tap fee for each such tap is \$500.00 plus costs. For any vacant lot where the service is provided under the initial provision of service, only the tap fee is required. For any property where the initial service is not paid for the fee is the tap fee plus the costs the City paid for the work already done.

Section 3. Repealer. Any Ordinance to the contrary or which conflicts with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. Severability. If any part, sentence, subsection or section of this Ordinance is unenforceable, illegal or ruled by a Court to be unenforceable, illegal or invalid, for any reason then the remaining parts, sentences, subsections or sections shall be of full force and effect, it being the intention of the City Council to pass each part, sentence, subsection or section fully and independently of any other part, sentence, subsection or section.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be effective upon the publication of its caption twice in the official newspaper of the City of Ingleside on the Bay.

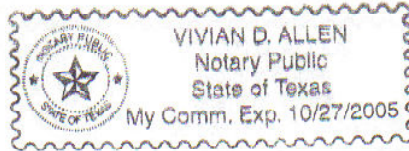
