AN ORDINANCE DECLARING EACH UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE IN THE MAY 4, 2024 ELECTION ELECTED TO OFFICE WITHOUT REQUIREMENT OF VOTE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLESIDE ON THE BAY, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City Council has received a certification of unopposed status from the City Secretary certifying that Jo Ann Ehmann as Mayor and a Candidate for the Election; Timothy Jolly and Thomas Merrick as Council Members on the City Council and Candidates for the Election are unopposed for the three vacancies, only one candidate's name is to be placed on the ballot for each office and no candidate's name is to be placed on a list of write-in candidates. The certification is attached hereto as Exhibit 1. The City Council pursuant to Texas Election Code, Chapter II, Subchapter C. Section 2.051 – 2.053, et seq, orders and declares Jo Ann Ehmann as Mayor; Timothy Jolly and Thomas Merrick as Council Members; as unopposed candidates are elected to the office of Mayor and City Council.

Section 2. A certificate of election shall be issued to each such candidate in the same manner as provided for a candidate elected at the election.
